Purpose: This monthly report is issued for each of four months (i.e., February, March, April, and May) every year by the Water Forum Successor Effort to provide the status of the March through November Unimpaired Inflow into Folsom Reservoir (March-Nov UIFR). Per the Water Forum Agreement of 2000, this hydrologic index is used to determine the type of water year and may be used by American River water purveyors and water right holders to determine the extent of their dry-year procedures. Projected Mar-Nov UIFR for May 2008 is 1019 TAF. This appears to be an Above Average Year.

Figure 1. History of UIFR Projections During 2008

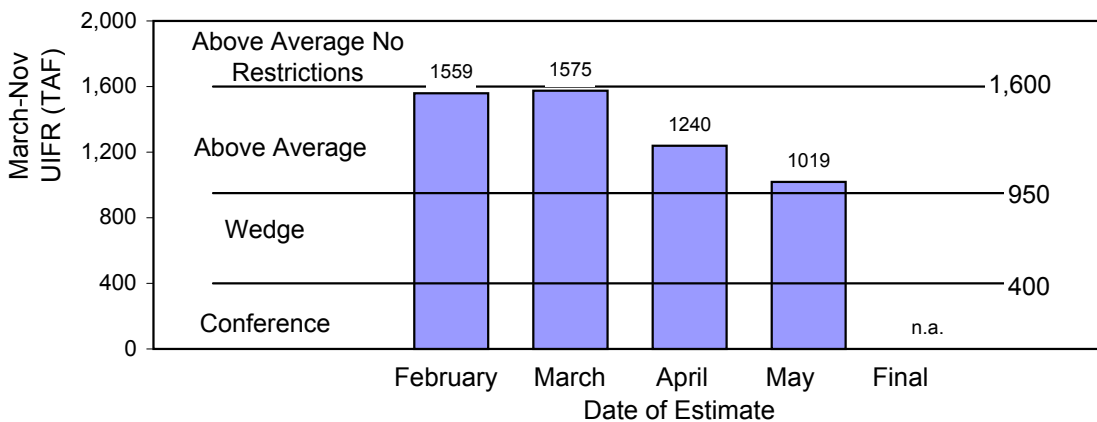
